### Introduction

### Personal Information We Collect

We collect and process various types of personal information to provide our physiotherapy services and to comply with legal obligations. The types of personal data we may collect include but are not limited to:

Name, address, and contact details (phone number, email address)

Date of birth

Medical history and current health condition

Insurance information

## Payment details

Any relevant information necessary for providing physiotherapy services

## How We Use Your Personal Information

We use your personal information for the following purposes:

- a. **Providing Physiotherapy Services:** We process your data to administer physiotherapy treatments, create personalized treatment plans, and maintain your health records.
- b. **Communication:** We may contact you to provide appointment reminders, share important updates, and respond to your inquiries.
- c. **Payment Processing:** We process your payment information for billing purposes and to complete transactions related to our services.
- d. **Legal Obligations:** We may use your data to comply with legal and regulatory requirements, such as reporting adverse incidents or cooperating with authorities if required.
- e. **Marketing:** With your explicit consent, we may use your contact information to send you marketing communications about our services and promotions.

## Legal Basis for Data Processing

We will only process your personal data when we have a valid legal basis to do so. The legal bases for processing your data include:

## **Your Rights**

Under the GDPR, you have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- c. Right to Erasure: You can request the deletion of your personal data under certain circumstances.

e. Right to Data Portability: You can request the transfer of your data to another data controller in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format.
